# Information

The **third regional HousErasmus+ conference** will take place in **Budapest, Hungary** – a two-day conference targeting stakeholders in the field of student housing.

The accommodation will be the beautiful **Mercure Budapest Korona Hotel**, a **4-star** hotel on Kálvin square in the **heart of Budapest**.

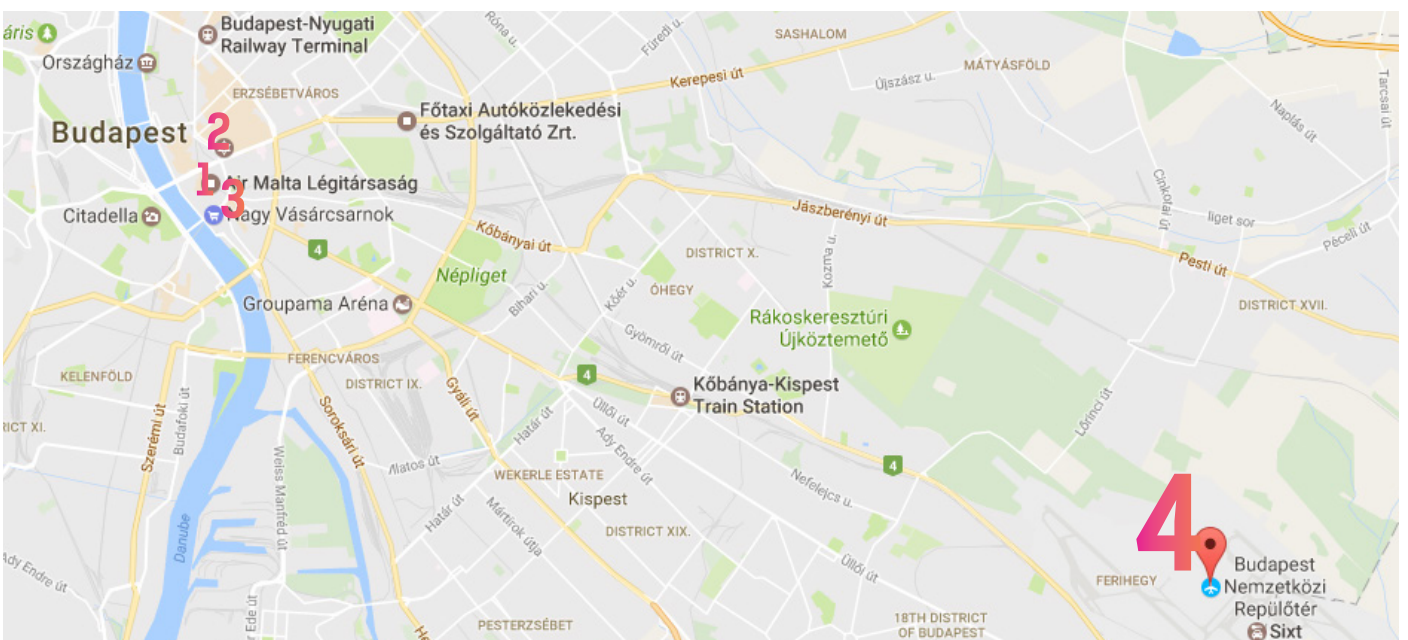

## How to get to the hotel

**Public transport from Nyugati railway station to the hotel (1€):**
